“Alabama Voters Strongly Support and Strongly Oppose a Range of Legislative Proposals”

The recently completed *Capital Poll* on gambling of 515 Alabama registered voters shows that Alabama voters strongly want their legislators to vote for: labeling foreign foods (84%); disclosure of original source of campaign funds (83%); voter recall of elected officials (82%); **standard public school starting date (83%);** property tax appraisal every four years (80%) and, a daily 15 minute recess for grades 1-4 (81%).

Voters want their legislator to vote against: increase taxes on automobile tags to hire more state troopers (57%); toll roads (55%); gasoline tax based on percentage of the price (51%); and, strongly against providing tax incentives to the film industry, if funds would come from education (82%).
